

PRAYER REQUESTS

FANNY SMITH had a bronchoscope procedure Wednesday. The doctor took three biopsies from her bronchial tubes and is concerned for the congestion she is experiencing. He prescribed an antibiotic and increased the prednisone to 60 mg per day with a taper back down to 10 mg per day over the next few weeks. Fanny is on prednisone all the time, just not that high. He will let her know the results of the biopsies after the cultures are grown to show the extent of fungus (aspergillus) present. Then he will decide whether or not to treat the fungus. A final evaluation will be made regarding the sarcoidosis to determine if another round of remicaid is needed. Pray for a good diagnosis and for healing.

ROBERT GROSS may have had a very mild mini stroke at work on Thursday. His hand and the side of his face went numb. His blood pressure was high so the K-25 Medical sent him on to the hospital where tests were run. Everything was OK except for the carotid artery.
